A **SMALL STEM**, is a stem of roses with not more than three flowers open. (See page 3)

A <u>LARGE STEM</u>, is a stem of roses with four or more flowers open. (See page 3)

**NOTE** - There are size restrictions in some classes - **Please** use a tape measure or similar tool.

- In the Novelty Classes, the measurements are a guide only.

# REGULATIONS FOR THE EXHIBITION OF ROSES

- 1. The show will be judged strictly in accordance with the Official Rules for the judging of roses of the New Zealand Rose Society Inc. as revised May 1993 and exhibitors should be conversant with these rules.
- 2. The Waikato Rose Society's schedule consists of Open, Novice, First Time Exhibitor, Senior Classes, Old Fashioned/English Type Roses and Novelty Section.

**OPEN SECTION** defined as open to all exhibitors.

- **NOVICE SECTION** An exhibitor may remain a novice for three consecutive years and thereafter until he/she has won three firsts or the points prize in any Novice Section.
- 3. **POINTS PRIZES** 3 points for 1st, 2 points for 2nd, 1 point for 3rd in any class. Excluding all Medal Classes.
- 4. N.Z.R.S. Classes are confined to New Zealand Rose Society Inc. members only when specified in the Schedule. A financial member of a District Rose Society is automatically classified as a member of New Zealand Rose Society Inc.
- 5. Roses exhibited in competition shall be named where possible, grown outdoors and be the exclusive property of the exhibitor for at least three months prior to the show.
- 6. Society vases to be used in all classes unless otherwise specified.
- 7. Staging material i.e. moss, paper, oasis etc. must not be above the top of the container except in bowl and basket classes.
- 8. All exhibits shall remain untouched until the close of the show. The Society will not be responsible for any loss or damage whatsoever.
- 9. Collapsed blooms may be replaced after judging. A "Replaced Bloom' card must be placed beneath the replaced bloom or blooms.
- 10.Entries shall be in the hands of the secretary at the stated closing time. All exhibits must be ready for judging at the appointed time. No unauthorised person shall be allowed in the hall while judging takes place.
- 11. Judges will have no interest in the classes which they are judging.
- 12.A Chief Judge will be appointed, who will confer with the Chief Steward and issue instructions to Judges. All details will be clarified before proceeding to judge any of these classes.
- 13. Where special and champion awards are to be made, Judges in each section will select suitable exhibits. These are to be placed on an award table, where the Champion Panel Judges must collaborate before a final decision is made. If necessary, the Chief Judge has the casting vote.
- 14. All protests must be made in writing and lodged with the Secretary by 3.00 p.m. on the first day of the show. No protest shall be considered against the decision of the Judges, except on the grounds of irregularity. The decision of the Disputes Committee shall be final.
- 15. In all matters of questions arising out of the application and interpretation of these regulations, including the eligibility of an exhibitor, the decision of the Disputes Committee shall be final.
